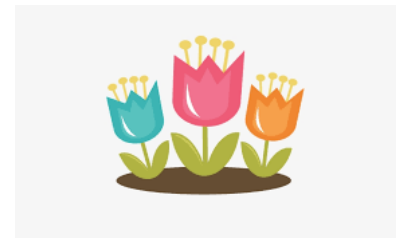

In creating classes, the goal is always to work on creating the most effective and positive learning environment possible. This is dependent on many factors, one being classroom dynamics. We strive to ensure that classes are balanced by looking at students' academic levels, special needs in the areas of academics, socio-emotional and behavior profiles, as well as individual personalities which include student/student relationships and teacher/student relationships. Much time and effort are put into creating these learning environments and it is important to recognize that all of these factors influence one another. For this reason, we do not accept placement requests. We ask that you trust the school team which includes your child's teacher to place them in the best suited class and to understand that the teacher is not the only factor considered when placing your child in a class. 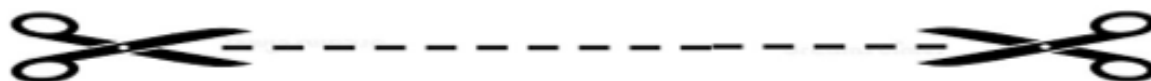
