# JK/SK/Grade 1

## Registration for 2023/24

Registration for new students for the 2023/2024 school year begins on Monday, January 23 and runs until Friday, February 10. Current Jeanne Sauvé students do not need to re-register for next year.

**If you have children born in 2019 (JK), 2018 (SK) or 2017 (Gr 1) please see the information below:**

### **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION:**

If you wish to apply for a spot in our junior kindergarten class, you must first register your child ([www.tvdsb.ca](http://www.tvdsb.ca) and click on 'Register for School') at YOUR HOME ENGLISH SCHOOL and then fill out the secondary form entitled '**Application for Student to Attend the English Kindergarten Program in their Designated French Immersion School**'. This form is only available from your home English school and must be returned to your home English school by the deadline of Feb 10. If the number of applications exceeds the number of available spots, a lottery system will be used to determine who is accepted and who is placed on the waitlist. The acceptance information will be sent out in late February or early March.

If you applied last year for your child to attend JK at Jeanne Sauvé and your child was placed on the waitlist and is currently at a TVDSB school, you can apply again for SK by contacting your child's school to fill out the '**Application for Student to Attend the English Kindergarten Program in their Designated French Immersion School**'. You do not need to fill out the complete school registration again – just the single page application. If your child is not at a TVDSB school, you must complete the online registration and the application form. It must be returned to your child's home English school by February 10.

### **GRADE 1 REGISTRATION:**

To register for Grade 1, please go to [www.tvdsb.ca](http://www.tvdsb.ca) and click on 'Register for School'. This is an online process. Once you have successfully submitted the registration form, we will contact you regarding documentation such as proof of birth for your child and proof of address.

We are holding a Grade 1 Information Night on Wednesday, February 8 at 7 pm here at the school. There will be a short presentation and an opportunity to ask questions. If you have neighbours or family members that are considering French Immersion for their child, please encourage them to attend!




