Register to Ride!

Bus registration for next school year is now open! To schedule bus service more effectively for students, Southwestern Ontario Student Transportation Services (STS) has an **annual mandatory transportation registration process for students who are eligible for bus service**. This form does not apply to students who use specialized/accessible transportation to meet their unique needs. **Students who are using the school bus must register every year.**

Know Your Student ID:

Prior to registering, families should also make sure they know the Student ID number. Student IDs are available in the STS Parent Portal or your School Board Parent Portal.

Registration Due Date:

Transportation Applications will be closed on July 15, 2023 so that routes can be finalized before the start of school. Families who register for the bus after July 15th may experience delays and transportation may not be in place for the start of school.

You don't need bus service next year?

No action is required. School bus service is a shared ride environment, with multiple students using the space over the course of the day. Some families may not wish to use bus service for personal reasons. **If you are not using bus service, you do not need to register.** We understand that your circumstances may change, if they do, please fill in a registration form at that time.

July 2023 FREE Virtual Programs for FSL Students

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The **Canadian Parents for French (CPF)** association will be offering **FREE French language support and enrichment opportunities** for French Immersion and Core French students in Grades 1 to 12 throughout the province. These voluntary programs will be offered remotely from July 4-28, 2023, and will feature a **daily 45-minute class over a 2-week session**. These programs are fully funded by the Ministry of Education and will be **led by certified OCT teachers and/or teacher candidates** enrolled in an Ontario Bachelor of Education program.

Program Offerings:

- **CPF VIRTUAL “Franco-Fun”:** Students in Grades 1-8 will participate in fun and interactive games and activities, and will chat with new friends while building their French vocabulary, oral comprehension, and communication skills;
- **CPF VIRTUAL Reading Circle:** Students in Grades 1-8 will read accessible books, articles, poems and other reading materials with new friends, and will learn new vocabulary and improve their reading comprehension skills;
- **CPF VIRTUAL “Vive la parole” Conversation Club:** Students in Grades 7-12 will engage in fun, theme-based games and interactive activities that spark oral communication in French and will learn about Franco-Ontarian pop culture.
