Registration for next year opens on January 15 and runs until February 2. **You do not need to register if your child is already attending Jeanne Sauvé**; we assume all current students will return, unless you tell us otherwise. But if you have younger children, please ensure they are registered for next year by the deadline of February 2, 2024. # Registration for New Students

Registration for new students for the 2024/2025 school year begins on Monday, January 15 and runs until Friday, February 2.

**CURRENT JEANNE SAUVÉ STUDENTS DO NOT NEED TO RE-REGISTER FOR NEXT YEAR.**

**If you have children born in 2020 (JK), 2019 (SK) or 2018 (Gr 1) please see the information below:**

## **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION:**

If you wish to apply for a spot in our junior kindergarten class, you must first register your child online for their HOME ENGLISH SCHOOL and then fill out the secondary form entitled '**Application for Student to Attend the English Kindergarten Program in their Designated French Immersion School**'. This form is only available from your home English school and must be returned to that school by the deadline of February 2. If the number of applications exceeds the number of available spots, a lottery system will be used to determine who is accepted and who is placed on the waitlist. The acceptance information will be sent out in late February or early March.

If your JK child is currently at a TVDSB school, you can apply for SK by contacting your child's school to fill out the '**Application for Student to Attend the English Kindergarten Program in their Designated French Immersion School**'. You do not need to fill out the complete school registration again – just the single page application. If your child is not at a TVDSB school, you must complete the online registration and the application form. It must be returned to your child's home English school by February 2. If the number of applications exceeds the number of available spots, a lottery system will be used again to determine who is accepted and who is placed on the waitlist.

## **GRADE 1 REGISTRATION:**

To register for Grade 1, please go to [www.tvdsb.ca](http://www.tvdsb.ca) and click on 'Register for School'. This is an online process. Once you have successfully submitted the registration form, you will be prompted to upload proof of birth and proof of address. We will contact you once the process is complete.

We are holding a Grade 1 Information Night on Tuesday, January 16 at 6:30 pm here at the school. There will be a short presentation and an opportunity to ask questions. If you have neighbours or family members that are considering French Immersion for their child, please encourage them to attend!

## Bus Cancellation Reminders

With the potential for inclement weather over the next couple of months, we wanted to take a moment to remind you of the procedures when buses are cancelled.

Please visit [www.mybigyellowbus.ca](http://www.mybigyellowbus.ca) to sign up for notifications about delays. You can also download the BusPlanner Delay App and sign up for notifications this way. This will allow you to receive updates directly from Student Transportation Services regarding bus cancellations or delays. If a bus is cancelled in the morning, it is cancelled for the entire day. If you choose to drive your child to school, you must be also pick them up at 2:45 pm.

In rare instances, schools may also be closed due to inclement weather. Please listen to local radio stations or visit the board website to monitor these announcements.
