October 2 5:30-6:30



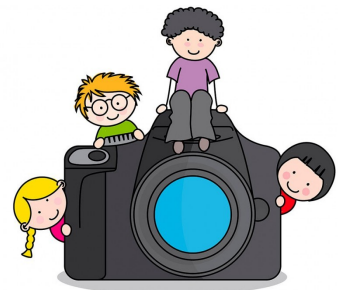
Please join us on Monday, October 2 from 5:30-6:30 pm to meet this year's teaching staff and to see your child's classroom.
